




Established in 2012, the David Douglas Society promotes the legacy of this explorer and plant collector who visited Oregon, Washington and British Columbia in the early 1800s.

Douglas traveled along the Columbia, Willamette and Fraser Rivers seeking new plants and trees to send back to England where many now flourish in gardens and forests. More than eighty species are named after Douglas; however, his most important contribution may have been his observations of Northwest tribes and how they used plants for food, cordage, clothing, housing, transportation and medicine.
